<b>For Illustrator *** Documents:</b>	* Fonts Outlined * Bleed Set at 1/4" * Document setup: CMYK	* Fonts * Placed Images (180 dpi)	* The quality of placed images will reflect how they will print in Illustrator.  * Please refer to Photoshop Documents for details.
<b>For InDesign *** Documents:</b>	* Fonts Outlined * Bleed Set at 1/4" * Document setup: CMYK	* Fonts * Placed Images (180 dpi)	* The quality of placed images will reflect how they will print in InDesign.  * Please refer to Photoshop Documents for details.
<b>For Quark Xpress *** Documents:</b>	* Bleed Set at 1/4" * Document setup: CMYK	* Fonts * Placed Images (180dpi)	* The quality of placed images will reflect how they will print in Quark Xpress.  * Please refer to Photoshop Documents for details.
<b>For Photoshop *** Documents:</b>	* Fonts Rasterized * Document Setup at 180 dpi @ 100% output size * Bleed Set at 1/4" * Document setup: CMYK	* Saved as a .PSD, .tiff, or .eps	* If resolution is lower than 180 dpi @ 100%, the viewable quality might be distorted depending on the content of the file.  * This can be compensated by the image being viewed at a distance.
<b>For jpg, tiff, eps, and pdf Documents:</b>	* Fonts Outlined or Rasterized * Document Setup at 180 dpi @ 100% output size * Bleed Set at 1/4" * Document setup: CMYK	<u>If eps or pdf</u>  * Fonts Outlined * Placed Images (180dpi)	* If file is either eps or pdf, be sure to include placed images and or fonts.  * For pdf's please be sure to unlock any licensing restrictions before saving out the file. This includes restrictions placed on fonts embedded in the pdf.

## Color Mode Preferences:

To ensure accurate color results please have the file setup in CMYK color mode, not RGB.

**In Illustrator:** Check under File-->Document Color mode, make sure CMYK is Checked

**With InDesign:** Check under Edit-->Transparency Blend Space, and make sure **Document CMYK** is Checked

**In Photoshop:** Check under Image-->Mode, and make sure CMYK is Checked

**In Quark:** Check under Preferences-->Quark CMS, and make sure Color Management Active is Checked.

Select CMYK under Default Source Profiles and choose **Generic CMYK** Profile for both *Solid Colors and Images*.
